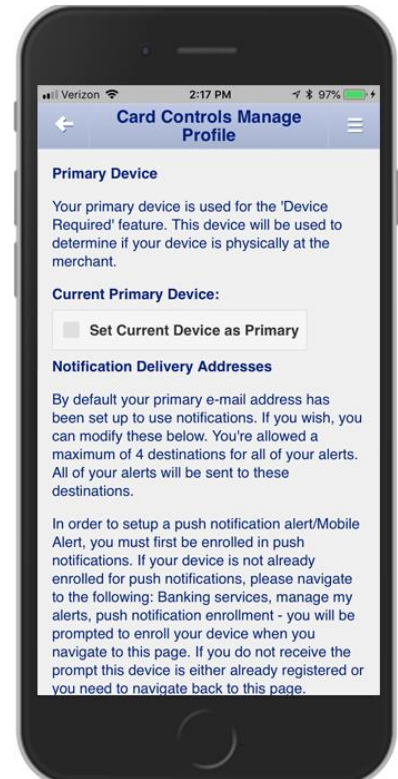

## Mobile Debit Card Alerts

- To set up the card alerts:
  - Update your mobile banking app if needed.
  - Login and choose Card Services from the menu.
  - Tap Manage Profile Settings.

Set primary device, and tap Add Destination to add your Notification Method. Email, text and/or push notifications\* (maximum of three delivery methods).

\*Push Notifications – need to enable in your phone settings to receive push notifications. When selecting Set Current Device as Primary (see screenshot at right), you will automatically be brought to your phone settings to enable Push Notifications.



- This feature within our Mobile Banking app replaces the current card alerts app, My Mobile Money.
- Each debit card user must have their own online and mobile banking profile in order to set up Mobile Debit Card Alerts.
- There are 3 ways to receive alerts: email, SMS (text – enter 10 digit phone number followed by carrier, see list at right), or Push Notifications\*.
- You will still need to notify us of their travel plans.
- If you set up merchant type alerts and also transaction type alerts, you may receive multiple alerts per transaction. When using your card at a gas station as a signature based (credit) transaction, you will first receive an alert on what the gas station set as the pre-authorized limit, then another alert when the actual amount that was pumped clears your account.

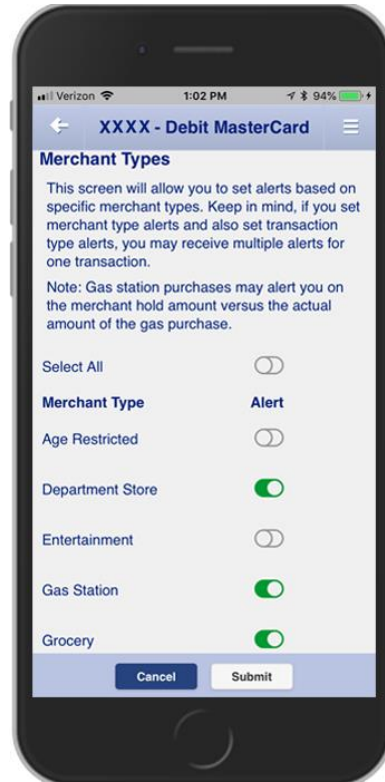
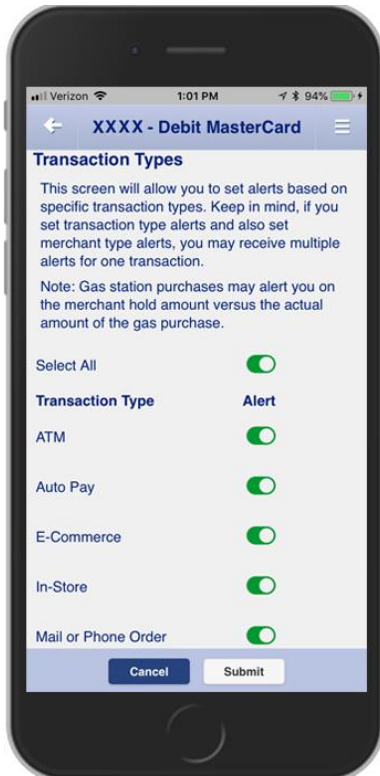

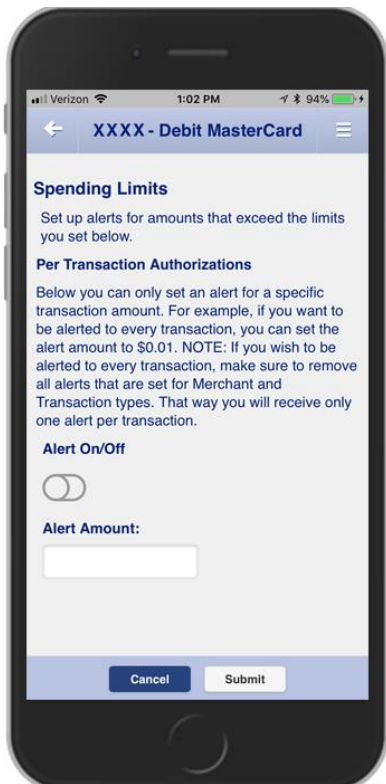

- There are many different types of alerts to choose from. Note: If you add both transaction and merchant type alerts you may receive multiple alerts for one debit card transaction.



- You can set your spending limit to a \$.01 if you would like to be alerted for every debit card transaction.



Alerts should be sent to you after you have made the purchase with your debit card. There may be a 1 – 2 minute delay.
